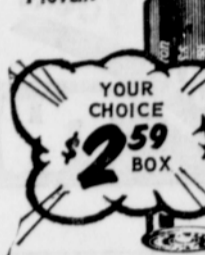

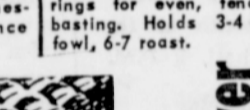

Animal Health Information for Pets Offered by Vet Association

Q. "Aren't fleas on dogs and cats inevitable? What's wrong with keeping my dog occupied with a little harmless scratching?"—Mrs. A.F.K.

A. Fleas aren't "inevitable"—and, if you were your dog, you wouldn't be philosophical about the situation.

For one thing, fleas transmit the intermediate stage of tape worm in dogs and cats; they cause persistent and sore skin inflammations which are most uncomfortable, and they also attack humans.

Flea control is and should be a year-round endeavor but most of the effort has to be made during the warm, dry months of summer when the flea propagation is at its peak.

Successful control of fleas depends on attacking the fleas both on the host animal and on the premises where the animal is kept. Since we're dealing with a colony of insects, control must be aimed both at the adult fleas and at the eggs and larvae of the flea.

Adult fleas normally spend all of their time on the animal. They lay their eggs on the skin and hair. The eggs fall off and accumulate where the animal spends most of his time, his bed, a favorite chair or rug. These areas then become a source of re-infestation.

Flea eggs can hatch in a day or two into larvae. The larvae, after

one or two weeks, spin a cocoon from which they emerge in another one or two weeks as adults.

Powders, sprays, bathing preparations and, in the case of dogs, insecticide tablets given orally, can control fleas on the animal. The same sprays or powders can be used to control fleas on the premises.

Here are a few basic points to remember:

1. Flea control has no "one-shot" solutions. Enough insecticide must be used to kill fleas on the host and in the "nursery" in order to break the insect's life cycle. Observation and occasional re-treatment will be necessary to prevent re-establishment of the problem from neighboring animals and premises.

2. Use good products and read all of the labels carefully. Get full directions on their use.

3. Follow the directions and precautions. Remember all flea preparations could do harm if mis-

QUESTION: My cleaning woman does not want social security credit and says she will quit if I deduct the tax from her pay. May I pay her share of the tax.

ANSWER: Yes. There is nothing in the law to prevent you from paying the entire amount of the social security tax including her share if you wish to do so. However, it may be better if she can be persuaded to contribute her

part since this will help her understand her responsibility and that she is paying toward future benefits that have real value. The social security office has several free booklets telling household workers of the protection they get through social security coverage. Get in touch with your local social security office for copies of the booklets.

QUESTION: Although I am now 65, I have been working in my own business, and I do not expect to retire. Would there be any advantage to my applying for retirement benefits even though I expect to earn more now than in the past?

ANSWER: It would be to your advantage to apply. It is possible for you to have some earnings and still receive some social security benefits. This would depend on the amount of your monthly benefit and on the amount of your yearly earnings. Also, for any month in which you are not actively working in your business you can still be paid a full benefit regardless of your yearly earnings. You should discuss this further with your social security office.
