Rites Read for Thomas Wolf

Funeral services for Thomas L. Wolf, 79, who had made his home here since 1942, were conducted Monday, October 8, at 1:00 p.m. at Fuiten's Chapel in the Hills Mortuary.

Rev. Bruce Roberts, pastor of the First Christian church, officiated with Mrs. Frank Serafin singing "In the Garden" and "God Be with You," accompanied by Mrs. Lloyd Thomas as organist. Concluding services and interment were at the Memorial cemetery with Rex McRae, Ike Dass, Clint Adams, Bob Asanerick, Tom Bateman and Ernie Herman serving as casket bearers.

Tom Wolf was born in Crook county, Kansas February 5, 1883 and spent his early life there. As a boy he participated with his parents in the Oklahoma Strip run where they took up a homestead. He spent most of his lifetime around Marshall, Oklahoma, coming to Oregon in 1942.

Mr. Wolf worked for Clark and Wilson, Sam Wilson, Crown Zellerbach and the Oregon American before retiring.

He passed away October 4 at a Portland hospital following a number of years of failing health. Surviving is his wife, Mrs. Nellie Simpson Wolf, to whom he was united in marriage at Oklahoma City August 23, 1921.

Also surviving are nine children: Home Wolf, Berkeley, California; Catherine Dailey, Portland; Mrs. Woodward (Ruth) Sullivan, Vernonia; Cecil Wolf, Odessa, Texas; Francis, Vernonia; John, Springfield, Oregon; Jack, Portland; Tom of Gaston and Mrs. Ralph (Nellie Marie) Anderson, Vernonia. Another daughter, Mary Lou Wolf, preceded him in death here in December, 1948.

Additional survivors include two sisters, Mrs. Omega Murphy, Pawhuska, Oklahoma; Mrs. Maude Rhoades, Odessa, Texas; 14 grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

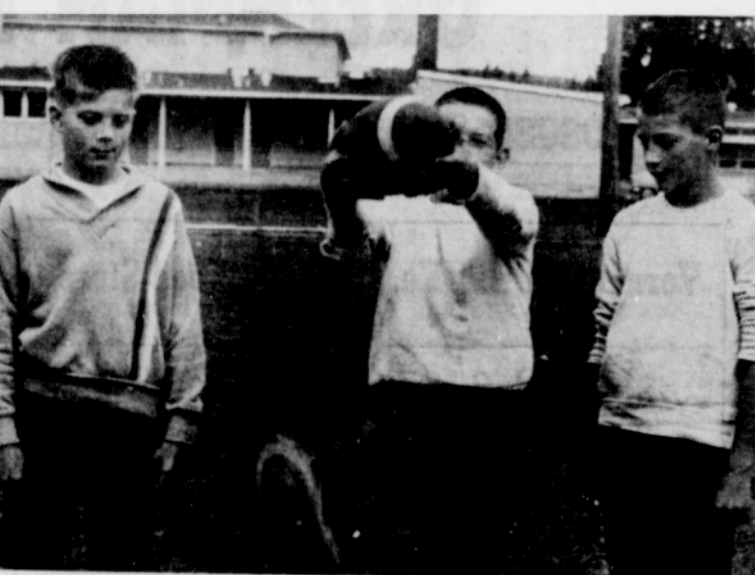
