Fair Judges Pick Winners of 4-H Displays, Project Skills

Two hundred ninety-three Columbia county 4-H club boys and girls exhibited their skills with their 4-H club projects at the Columbia county fair. Several 4-H club members outstanding in their fields were selected by the judges. Margaret Magruder of Clatskanie was selected as the outstanding girl in home economics to receive a 4-H club summer school scholarship for 1965.

Heather Higgenbotham of Vernonia, a second year 4-H club member, received honorable mention for her outstanding performance in all home economics activities. She received the highest score in the home eco-

nomics department but was not old enough to be selected to go to 4-H club summer school. She received many wonderful compliments from the judge for her charm, poise and skill in preparing and serving a luncheon for four people in the Meal Preparation contest.

Kathy Cox of Scappoose was selected the outstanding club member in the 4-H clothing division and was awarded a 4-H club summer school scholarship for 1965 from the J. C. Penney store in St. Helens.

Charles Stevely of Warren was selected the grand champion 4-H livestock showman of the fair and was winner of the Maple Meadows 4-H club trophy for the best fitted animal; Margaret Magruder was champion showman in both beef and swine divisions; Dick Magruder was champion 4-H sheep showman.
