

QUESTION: A cousin of mine was killed last year. He wasn't married and the lump-sum death payment went to his brother because he paid the funeral bill. My cousin had been supporting his parents for years, but a friend said there was no need for them to visit the social security offifties. Was that good advice? ANSWER: No. While it's true that

your cousin's dependent parents can't get benefit payments until they're 62, they must file evidence soon with social scurity to prove their dependency. This proof of dependency must be filed within two years of the date of your cousin's death. The social security people have the forms and will be glad to help your cousin's parents fill them
