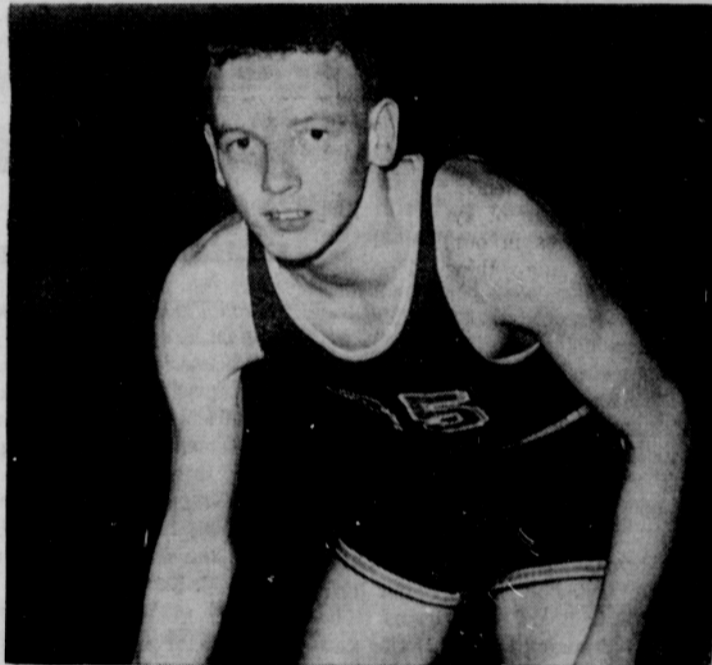

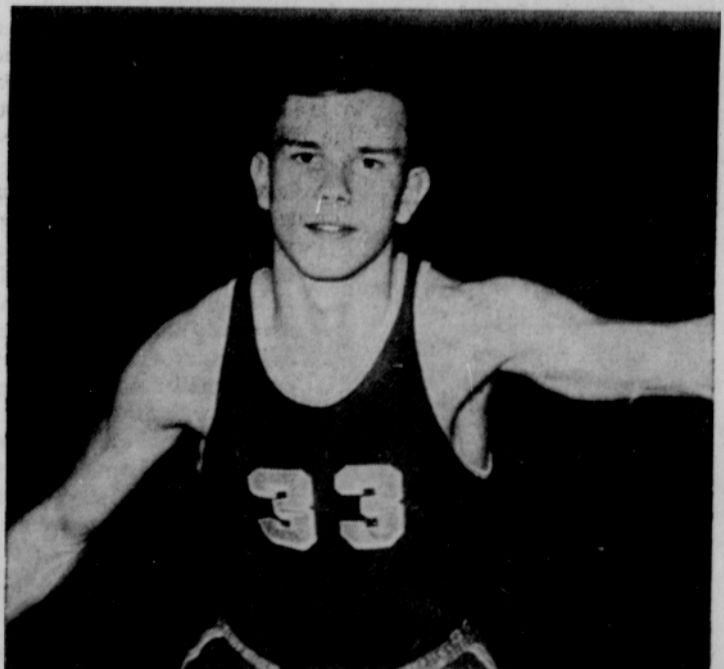


RUSS REDMOND, Guard, is a senior and is playing his second year of varsity ball.
