RESOLUTION NO.— WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Vernonia has conferred with the Vernonia Rural Fire Protection District concerning the annexation of the City into the Vernonia Rural Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Rural Fire Protection District have the same Fire Chief and Fire Officers; and

WHEREAS, the equipment of said Rural District is used in conjunction with the City Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Rural District have agreed as to ownership and values of the various firefighting equipment and have agreed as to its transfer to the Rural District; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Rural District have agreed as to the use of the City fire station until a new fire station can be financed and built within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District are of the opinion that improvement of training of manpower, better use of facilities and added facilities can be expedited by the annexation of the City to the District; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Rural Fire Protection District find it to be to the advantage of both the City and the District to allow the City to be annexed into the Rural Fire District, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Vernonia requests that the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission proceed to have the City of Vernonia annexed to the Vernonia Rural Fire District.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 13th day of March, 1972, by and between the City of Vernonia, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called the City, and the Vernonia Rural Fire Protection District, hereinafter called the District.

The City and the District have requested the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission to annex the City into the District and this agreement is contingent upon said annexation. Otherwise this agreement shall be considered null and void.

It is agreed and understood as follows:

1. The District shall furnish fire protection to the best of its ability to the City residents and the District will attempt to obtain a better fire rating within the entire District but will fully cooperate with the City in an attempt to lower the City rate.

2. The City will cooperate and assist the District in an effort to lower the rate. This applies to water supply, pressure, hydrants, etc. which are under the control of the said City but are rated by the Fire Insurance Rating Bureau within the District.

3. Due to the small budget of the District, the City will permit the District to use its present Fire Station with utilities for the period of time not to exceed ten years until the District can finance and construct its own fire station and facilities.

4. The fire fighting equipment now owned by the City shall be transferred to the District who will use and maintain said equipment. Provided, however, if, for any reason, the City withdraws from the District and proposes to once again provide fire fighting facilities for its residents, then in such an event, the District shall return all of the equipment transferred from the City to the District and all additional equipment obtained subsequent to the annexation shall be divided in a pro rata proportion based on the assessed valuation in the City and District at the time of disaffirmation. The City will make and execute all documents necessary to satisfactorily transfer titles to the District.

5. The funds created to purchase fire fighting equipment now in the possession of the City shall be expended for a new fire truck purchased with the advice of the District and said truck and equipment will be transferred to the District. In the event the City cannot pay the purchase price for said new fire fighting equipment, then at the time of the transfer the District will assume and agree to pay the balance of the purchase price of said equipment. This may be done by the assumption of a lease-purchase agreement or whatever financing arrangements have been entered into by the City.

6. It is understood that there is a vacancy on the District Board of Directors and that the Board will agree to appoint a City resident who will have the approval of the City Council.

7. It is the hope and belief that this merger will result in better fire protection to all property within the new unified District and both parties pledge their support and will endeavor to provide better fire protection to all parties in the new unified District.
