There will be many of them on display February 21-25 in Portland's Memorial Coliseum for the 1973 Portland Mobile Home Show.

Mobile Homes Readied for Annual Show

Every year new records keep being set in almost every sport and competitive event in the country. This year's Mobile Home Show is no exception, even though it is not billed as a sport or competitive event.
When the new '73 models of mobiles are inched into the Coliseum for the Portland Mobile Home Show, February 21-25, the sport of competition will be high among the men who must place the new "mobile housing" if for no other reason than to make the units fit into the concrete and glass structure of the coliseum.
Last year two record breaking display, 70 feet long each, were jockeyed into position to be advertised as the biggest such structures ever exhibited in Oregon. According to Cliff Kennedy, this year's show president, there are already four such Mobile Homes signed up for the show.
And that's not all. This year the trend seems to be to display units that are wider than usually shown. Kennedy says, "We have a half dozen coaches measuring 24 feet wide and a specially designed home, the size of which has never been displayed in the Northwest. That's a mobile home 28 feet wide and 70 feet long. How we plan on getting all that into the coliseum is beyond me. I'm leaving that up to my move-in committee!"
A couple of modular homes are scheduled for this 1973 Mobile Home Show to be set in the familiar park-like setting which has become a standard feature of the show. "There will be an entire city under one roof," quips Kennedy, "if we can just get it all in there!"
Hours of the show are: Wednesday and Thursday, 6-11 p.m.; Friday and Saturday, 1-11 p.m. and Sunday, 1-7 p.m. Friday, Senior Citizens may enter for 1/2 price from 1-6 p.m. General admission for adults is \$2, students 6-16, \$1, under 6, free.

Shrine Selects Jim Bernhardt

Head coaches have been named for the annual east-west high school Shrine football game to be played August 18 in Pendleton, Oregon.
Named to head the west squad is Scappoose High's Jim Bernhardt, while the head east mentor will be Tom Vaught of Gladstone.
Bernhardt took his last year's Scappoose Indian gridders to the state AA championship game, losing to Vaught and his Gladstone squad. Vaught and his Gladstone captured the AA crown for the second consecutive year last fall.
Assisting Bernhardt will be Gerald Gibson of Santiam, while named as assistant coach for the east is Lee Schroeder of Lost River High School.
Rosters for the two squads will be announced following the selection meeting in Portland on February 24.
