Higher Price Ups Payments

Burton W. Silcock, director of the Bureau of Land Management, Department of the Interior, recently presented checks amounting to \$40,735,698.45 to representatives from Oregon's 18 O&C counties.

The money is payment to the counties for their share of the revenue from timber sales on re-vested Oregon and California Railroad grant timberlands in western Oregon. The payment represents the counties' share of the revenue collected during the eleven-month period from July 1, 1972 to May 31, 1973. A final accounting of additional funds due the counties from June collections will be made in August.

This year's payment is seven million dollars greater than last year's. The increase is primarily because of higher sale prices for western Oregon timber this year.
Columbia County's share of O&C funds is \$839,155.39.

HELP Assists 493 Families In County Jan. 1 - June 30

According to figures released this week by Jim Eckland, program director for Columbia County's HELP, Inc., that agency has assisted, both directly and indirectly, a total of 493 families during the period from January 1 to June 30, 1973.

HELP, Inc. receives an average of about 300 calls per month for a total of 1743 for the first six months of 1973. Types of requests received by the agency included: Transportation, 121 (mostly for medical appointments); Housing information and requests, 34; Help Wanted (Employment), 70; Child Care information, 59; Legal Aid, 16; Employment wanted, 53; Inter-Agency referrals, 126; Family Planning, 7; Alcohol information, 18; Financial Assistance, direct, 16 and Referrals 10; Requests for Homemakers (both live-in and drop-in), 24; Emergency Food, 42; Crisis-type calls (majority at night), 11.

Besides taking care of emergency needs and referring persons to the appropriate organization, HELP, Inc. has also been working cooperatively with other agencies in the training of homemakers. That initial training session ended June 28, with a dozen ladies completing the course. Persons in need of a trained homemaker may now phone the HELP office at 397-3511 and make a request.

HELP has also been designated the information and referral agency for the Columbia County Alcohol Council, where persons wishing information on alcohol and its related problems are invited to contact the above phone number.

Another accomplishment has been the updating of the Resource Directories that were distributed throughout the county last January. Persons who now have a copy of the directory may obtain the corrections, additions and changes by contacting the HELP office.

"Volunteers," according to Eckland, "are the backbone of our organization. Even if it is just donating a can of food to the emergency food cupboard or taking someone to the doctor periodically, it all helps!"

HELP is currently working closely with the Volunteer Services Coordinator at the Adult and Childrens Service office to avoid overlap and duplication.
