## PUBLIC NOTICE

### CITY OF VERNONIA NOTICE OF BOND SALE

Notice is hereby given that sealed, written bids will be received by the undersigned until 4:00 p.m. on the 20th day of August, 1973, and immediately thereafter publicly opened by the City of Vernonia, a municipal corporation, in the City Council Chambers at the City Hall, located at 919 Bridge Street, Vernonia, Oregon, for the purchase of "City of Vernonia General Obligation Improvement Bonds, Series 1973", in the amount of \$65,644.16.

The bonds will be dated September 1, 1973. Bond No. 1 will be in denomination of \$644.16 and the remainder in denominations of \$5,000.00 each, numbered 2 to 14 inclusive, and will mature serially in numerical order and in ten annual installments as follows:

\$5,644.16 - September 1, 1974  
\$5,000.00 - September 1, 1975, and the first day of September each year thereafter through and including September 1, 1980.

\$10,000.00 - September 1, 1981, and the first day of September each year thereafter through and including September 1, 1983.

The bonds are General Obligation Improvement Bonds of the City of Vernonia, and are to be paid from taxation to be levied and collected by the City of Vernonia, and from collections on applications to pay for various improvements in installments. The interest on the bonds will be paid semi-annually on the 1st day of September and the 1st day of March of each year after issuance, the first payment of interest to be made on the 1st day of March, 1974.

The bonds shall have but one coupon for the interest due on any interest paying date.

All bids shall be in writing accompanied by a certified check, or cashier's check, on a bank doing business in the State of Oregon, in the sum of \$1313.00. The bonds will be sold to the responsible bidder offering to purchase the same at not less than par and accrued interest, and at the lowest net effective rate, not to exceed 7%. There shall not be a difference of more than two percent between the highest and lowest rates specified for the bonds. Supplemental coupons will not be allowed.

The unqualified written legal opinion of the law firm of Rankin, Walsh, Ragen & Roberts, Portland, Oregon, approving the validity of the bonds will be furnished to the successful bidder and printed on the bonds at the expense of the city.

The City of Vernonia reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
