

Columbia County Bank Debits Raise

Bank debits for the eight reporting banks including Columbia county were up in October, 1973, compared to October 1972, the University of Oregon Bureau of Business Research has reported.

Debits for October 1973, totalled \$28,037,000. For September, 1973, the total was \$25,311,000 and for October 1972, the total was \$25,588,000.

Oregon, with 426 banks reporting, had a percentage increase of 18.3 in October 1973, as compared with September 1973, and a 45.4 percentage increase in October 1973, compared with October 1972.

Total bank debits for October 1973, came to \$9,780,826,000. For September 1973, the total was \$8,270,880,000 and for October 1972, the total was \$6,729,142,000.

Building Permits Up In Columbia County

Building permits were up in Columbia County in October 1973, compared to October 1972, the University of Oregon Bureau of Business Research has reported.

In October 1973, the total was \$322,300 compared to \$158,384 in the same month last year. Building permits from 148 identical reporting centers in Oregon totalled \$82,144,945 in

October 1973. This was 34.6 percent higher than the total in October 1972.

The state total in October 1973, included \$28,166,096 for 1,533 new dwelling units; \$27,878,721 for new nonresidential construction; and \$26,100,128 for additions, alterations and repairs to existing structures.
