


#### Dear Steve:

In accordance with your request, our office contacted Mr. Ron Eshelby, Columbia County Building Inspector, in regard to apparent misunderstanding or misinterpretation of state laws governing mobile homes and mobile home dealers. We informed Mr Eshelby of the following facts:

- Mobile home dealers are licensed by the Motor Vehicles Division and must post a substantial bond (five times the amount posted by building contractors). This larger bond is necessitated by the wider scope of activities involved in a dealer's business (selling, trading, transporting, installation, servicing, arranging financing, placement of insurance, etc.). Please note that this license and bond includes installation of mobile homes. Mobile home dealers are not required to secure a buildcontractors license.
- 2. Senate Bill 73, passed by the Oregon State Legislature in 1973, specifically authorized the Director of the Oregon State Department of Commerce to adopt a statewide building code, which supersedes the building codes of cities and counties. Therefore, local building permits are not required for placement of mobile homes, either on private property or in mobile home parks. Jurisdic-tion of mobile home parks and plan approvals for con-struction of mobile home parks is under the State Health Division.
- 3. There are no state regulations or laws governing an-choring or "tie-down" of mobile homes.

Recent State of Oregon figures reveal that 63% of the people of Oregon are unable to purchase housing costing \$21,000 or more. The housing crisis is critical. The State of Oregon and progressive county officials recognize that mobile homes provide the only answer to the growing problem of housing. More than 50% of all new single-family dwellings erected in the U.S. this year will be mobile homes.


