One of the "sights" of the forthcoming Brussels exposition which the press bureau says "will be interesting to old and young alike," will be the monster tableau entitled "The Thuringer Kirmess." The hundreds of figures, representing all nationalities and all classes of society, and the background of the old-fashioned houses take up a space of nearly seventy-five square yards. The great group was designed and executed by Prof. Reinhard Moller, and the pictures of the lively fair scene which it represents show that attention has been given to the smallest details, and the exhibit is spoken of as "reflecting great credit on the toy industry of Thuringia, at whose order it was created."
