with the Committee on Public
Information at Washington, D.
C., and the Federal Reserve
bank at San Francisco to secure
a war exhibit which has been on
exhibit at San Francisco for sev-
eral weeks and it looks as if it
would be sent to Ontario fair
week.These features, with the Red
Cross Exhibit, the Federal Food
Conservation Exhibit to be sent
from Portland, the Military Air-
plane, the special premiums for
War Funds and Red Cross pro-

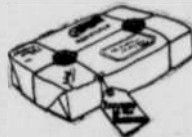
