### SERMONETTE

#### Man's True Glory.

Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, the mighty man in his might, the rich man in his riches. Jer. 9:22. It is sheerest folly for a man to glory in these. A number of years ago the emperor of Germany talked with the leading men of his nation of an ambitious plan for bringing the world under his sway. Speaking of other men who had aspired after world dominion, Alexander, Caesar, Napoleon, he said: "These men have all failed. I shall not fail because I shall be prepared." Preparation could not have been more complete. That nation's wisest men had devoted their knowledge to the production of means for making war swift, terrible, irresistible. Immense treasure had been accumulated for the successful prosecution of a mighty war of conquest. Glorifying in his wisdom, might and wealth, the Kaiser said, "we can fight the world." But as ever, "pride goeth before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall." Behold how are the mighty fallen! We know how the German armies swept over the neighboring countries like an over-running flood, leaving death and ruin in its wake. It seemed that nothing could stop its onward sweep. 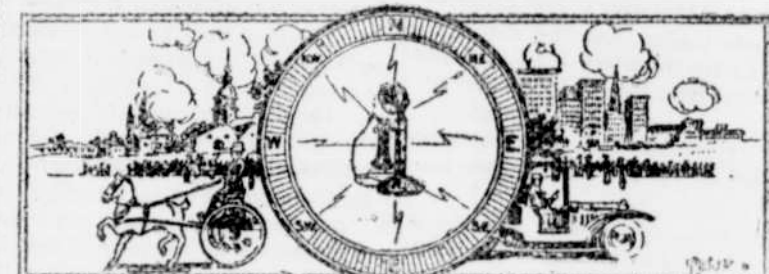
