NICARAGUA ASKS U. S. FOR HELP

Washington.—Nicaragua has asked the United States to land forces there to cope with a threatened invasion from Costa Rica. The state department is investigating the situation.

The Nicaraguan legation here in a statement declared that following the collapse of the revolution in Costa Rica, President Tinoco has massed large forces on the frontier.

Tinoco, whose brother as minister of war is at the head of the Costa Rican army in the field, has charged that the Nicaraguans aided the revolutionists. The Nicaraguans have denied the charge and cited that it was the liberal party in Nicaragua, members of the old Zelaya regime, that went over to Tinoco.

With a substantial marine guard in Nicaragua and a warship on each coast, the United States is prepared to protect that country from invasion by Costa Ricans, it was learned from official sources. No action is expected, however, pending the outcome of an investigation now being made by the state department.

A fine of \$50 was imposed by the circuit court at Astoria on Charles Marco on a charge of operating a purse seine in the waters of the Columbia river. The case was on appeal from the justice court, where a similar fine had been imposed, and notice of appeal was immediately taken to the state supreme court. The action, while of a criminal nature, is a friendly one to obtain the court's interpretation of the state law prohibiting purse seining in the Columbia river.

Captain Conrad Staffin of Dallas, who was recently returned from service in France with the 162nd infantry, was appointed adjutant general of the Oregon national guard, Governor Ben W. Olcott announced. The appointment will be temporary, the appointee to serve only until the return to duty of Lieutenant Colonel George A. White, now on his way home from France, now resigned the office two years ago on the understanding that he would be reappointed upon his return home.

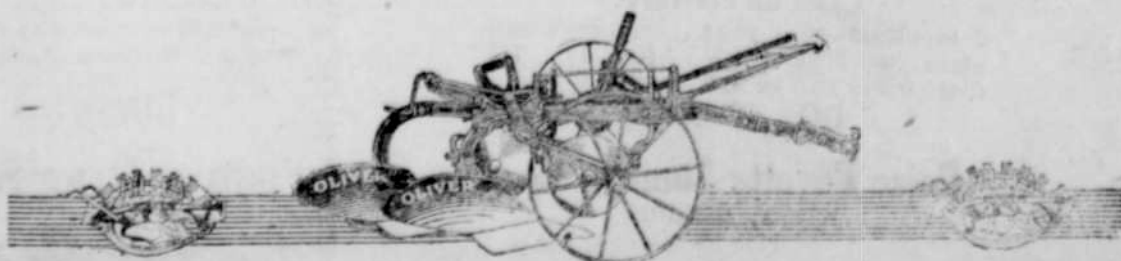
