Honey Recipes

(Prepared specially for The Journal by Mrs. W. W. Foster.)

MAKING CAKES WITH HONEY

Facts, taken from Government Bulletin No. 653; "Honey and its use in the Home."

In making cake with honey it is well to remember that honey being heavier than sugar contains, a little more sweetness, cup for cup and about 1 4 cup of moisture besides. So when substituting 1 cup of honey for one cup of sugar, use 1-4 less of liquid or about 1 2 cup (or more) more of flour. Honey is also slightly acid, and in using sweet milk and baking powder, add, about 1-4 teaspoon of soda for each cup of honey. In your own recipes which call for molasses, sour milk and soda, honey may be used instead of the molasses with excellent results and a much finer flavor. In another recipe the best results are usually obtained by using one half honey and one half sugar keeping in mind about the moisture and soda. These cakes will have a distinct honey flavor and keep moist for many days. If they dry out, put in a tight box or pail, cover closely, and they will regain their moisture. Two tablespoons of honey in an ordinary cake (use a little less liquid) will help to keep it fresh but will not give the flavor. Watch for special honey recipes to be published later. You'll like them.
