The Fair Board has arranged with the Ace Aircraft Corp. to have a machine here during the Fair, which will give a number of exhibition flights, doing all the stunts known to the game. A special feature will be night

flying with the plane illuminated. A number of passengers will also be taken up for a nominal charge.

A contract has been entered into with the Brown's Amusement Co., of San Francisco to provide for the carnival attractions. We will have the largest merry-go round in the United

States and a \$10,000 Ferris Wheel also 6 or 8 side shows and over 20 concessions.

Over \$500 have been subscribed by the business firms here which will be offered as special prizes, in addition to nearly \$4,500 cash premiums.

Special attention is being directed this year to the School children and it is expected that a separate tent or building will be set aside for their exhibits. One of the prizes offered is for the best story on "How they earned money for Thrift Stamps."
