"Boys' and Girls' Club Work is one of the important features of the Agricultural Extension Work conducted by the States Relation Service.

These objects are in process of attainment. Whenever Club Work has been pushed by our agents, large yields have been obtained, better pigs have been raised and finer cattle, both dairy and beef, have been grown.

The average yield per acre made by club members in the growing of field crops is two to three times as large as the average yields made in the States in which the members are located.

The money value of the products of club members is only a small part of the value of club work. Many boys and girls have had their vision of life enlarged by club membership.
