Nyssa, Oregon, Oct. 14.—Editor Journal: Through the columns of radical Republican newspapers in this county there appeared recently a paper signed by J. D. Fairmon, merchant of Harper, stating that because a wholesaler saw fit to send him some of Swift & Company's Argentine canned beef to sell, he was going to vote for Stanfield, instead of Senator Chamberlain. Mr. Fairmon and the Stanfield supporters evidently overlooked the propriety of howling about the importations of canned beef from Argentine when it would appear to be more loyal to home industry to kill and sell some of the many good beef steers that are raised in this country, and the best on earth, than to sell any kind of canned meat, whether raised in the East or in Argentine. In view of the fact that Stanfield and his interests are closely affiliated with the Swift interests, it would appear very unkind for the Stanfield supporters to criticize the Swift people for importing beef from Argentine. It has probably been overlooked by the Stanfield interests that, in spite of a Republican congress in full power the last two years, they have done absolutely nothing to protect either the cattlemen or sheepmen from foreign interests dumping their products on the American market, although such legislation was recommended by the President.

British Regret U. S. Flag Incident. Washington.—Regrets were officially expressed in connection with the trampling upon a United States flag by British sailors on July 4 at Bermuda, the state department was advised by the American consul there. The guilty sailors have been imprisoned, heavily fined and are undergoing naval punishment while the British magistrate who judged the case severely reprimanded the culprits, counsel advisers stated.
