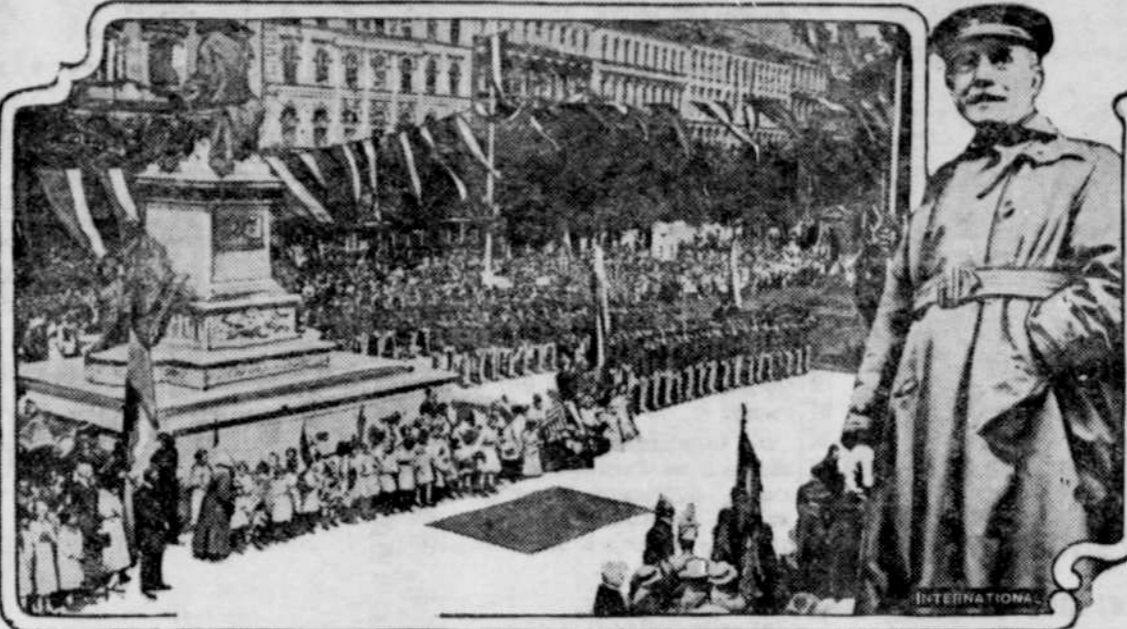

## THE ALLIGATOR BOY



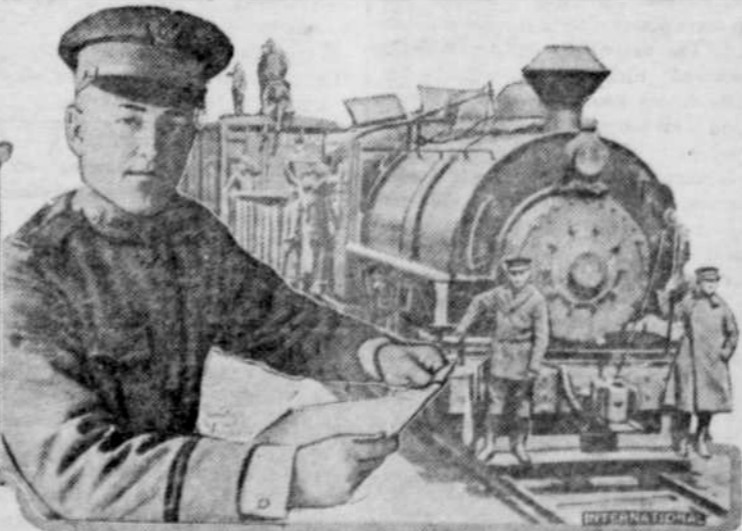
