University of Oregon, July 21,-Alhough there are approximately six housand public school teachers in dae state of Oregon, only thirty of them receive annual salaries of three housand dollars or more, according to figures brought out during the summer term of the University of There are 24 teaching pos-Uregon. itions carrying salaries between tweny-five hundred and three thousand dollars a year. School room jobs droughout the state with a compensation ranging between two thousand dollars and uwenty-five hundred a year number only 240. These figures include Portland. All the rest of the thousands of teachers, including hundreds of superintendents principals, and supervisors, receive less than two thousand dollars for delr services, though large numbers of them have spent four years in a university, college or normal school soveral superintendents in attend ance ut the University summer tern from the larger towns of the state report difficulty in completing their staffs for next year. There is still shortage of teachers, they say. The number of appointment calls oming in to the appointment bureau of the University further confirm this report of a teacher scarcity.
