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NOT A CHRISTIAN NATION

We recently listened to a discourse in which the speaker took the position that this is a Christian country. This point has been brought forward very frequently of late, so we suppose some very important result is expected if we can only convince ourselves that we are a Christian nation. The evidence, however, seems to point the other way. The very first amendment to the constitution says that congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, Christian or otherwise. a provision which effectually bars this nation from becoming Christian, Jewish, Buddhist, or anything else, officially speaking. Our government has never hesitated to make laws directly in violation of Christian teaching, whenever such laws seemed necessary for the good of the republic. An instance of this still fresh in the memory of all is the conscription law during the late war, by which Christian and non-Christian alike were forced to go to war, to take life, and to resist evil by carnal means, all of which things are expressly forbidden to the Christian. Yet we find men who presume to speak with authority as ordained ministers of God's word who will publicly proclaim that the government which enforced that law is a Christian government. Patriotic it was, and necessary from a human standpoint, but at the same time it was utterly un-Christian.

The truth is that ours is not a religious government of any kind, nor was it intended to be such. Religion is a personal matter, and when the people of this country become followers of Christ to such an extent that they may be justly entitled to the name of Christian, it will not be necessary for anyone to mount the pulpit and proclaim it as an important discovery, for "by their works ye shall know them." The Christian lives of the people will be the incontrovertible evidence of the fact that we are a Christian people. Does anyone think that such is the case at present?

Economic Conference For County Called

As the result of a meeting held in the office of County Agent L. E. Brethaupt Tuesday morning attended by L. B. Hamaker and E. M. Blodgett of the Commercial Club, Percy Purvis of Vale Commercial Club, W. H. Doolittle of Ontario Commercial Club, E. B. Conklin of Cairo, representing the Farm Bureau, F. L. Ballard and Mr. Brethaupt, representing the extension service, it was decided to hold a Malheur county economic conference in Ontario Thursday and Friday, March 6 and 7.

This conference is one of a series held in various counties at the state conference held recently at Corvallis, where many constructive plans for the betterment of conditions in Oregon were started.

The conference was divided into four major committees where those interested in specific problems and consider data upon specific crops and later report their findings to a general conference to follow. The committees will be divided as follows:

Fundamental development -- transportation, reclamation and land settlement problems will be considered by this division, of which W. H. Doolittle of Ontario will be chairman.

Animal husbandry section will consider dairy, poultry and livestock problems and conditions. I. W. Hope of Vale will be chairman.

Perishable farm products division will discuss the problems connected with apples, prunes, potatoes and vegetables. P. Tensen of Nyssa will be chairman of this division.

Staple farm crops division will consider, supply crops, cash feed and grain crops and feed crops. E. B. Conklin will be chairman of this section.

A general meeting of the committee chairmen was held February 22 to complete arrangements for the conference.
