## P.U. INDUSTRY TO SPEND LARGE SUM

Reports from the national capital convey the information that the public utility industry contemplates the expenditure of nearly one and one-half billions of dollars in new construction during the coming year. Pres. Matthew Sloan, of the National electric light association, said at the white house conference that the utility group also would spend \$410,000,000 for maintenance of existing plants, in addition to \$1,400,000,000 for construction, covering all sections of the country. These stupendous figures were made public by executives of electric light and gas plants and of street railways, who attended a conference upon invitation of President Hoover.

The gas industry will spend \$425,000,000 in 1930, according to President Mullaney, of the American Gas Company, and electric railway companies have an anticipated budget of one billion dollars for maintenance betterments and extension of equipment and plants. The Edison Electric Illuminating company of Boston alone will spend \$40,000,000 in its 1930 expansion program.

While executives of electric companies operating in Oregon are not prepared to announce definite plans, they indicated that
