In making cheese souffles, a more satisfactory product is obtained if the baking dish is set in a pan of water. The water is not allowed to boil.

Baking powder biscuits, if placed in a cool place and covered with a very thin wet cloth to prevent a crust forming, can be allowed to stand an hour or to before baking, without injury.

Too much beating is one of the most common causes of poor muffins. Baking powder biscuits, on the other hand, are often not mixed as much as would be desirable for the best texture.
