

NOTICE TO VOTERS

TO VOTE YOU MUST BE REGISTERED.

AS PROVIDED by Chapter 204, 1927 Laws, no person shall be qualified to vote at a Primary or General Election unless he shall be registered. Electors can not be sworn in election day. Registration books are now open and will be open until the night of April 19. If you are registered and did not vote at the last Primary or General Election, if you have changed your residence or if you desire to change your political affiliations, you must re-register.

You may register at the office of the County Clerk, for any precinct in the county, or with the official registrars in the following precincts.

PORTLAND JUDGE
FIRST TO ENTER
NON-PARTY RACE

J. O. Bailey, Portland, candidate for Judge of the supreme court, is first to announce himself a candidate on Oregon's first non-partisan ballot, to be called the "Judiciary Ballot." No party will appear on the ballot. It may be used by registered Republicans, Democrats and the electors of other parties. It will be a third ballot.

From 1915 until 1920 Mr. Bailey was assistant attorney general of Oregon. In 1928 he received both the Republican and Democratic nominations for senator of Multnomah county and was elected with the highest vote ever received by a candidate for the legislature.

Mr. Bailey plans a visit to Malheur county.
