

IDAHO WILL OIL HIGHWAY BETWEEN PARMA-CALDWELL

Thirteen miles of highway between Parma and Caldwell will be oiled. The contract was let Friday to Morrison-Knudson company, Boise. At present the highway is oiled to Parma and the new contract will extend the oiling to a point about seven miles from Caldwell. It is expected that the Idaho highway department will complete the oiling into Caldwell this year, thus giving motorists oiled highway from Caldwell to the junction with the Oregon highway at Nyssa.
