NOTICE OF ORGANIZATION OF JORDAN VALLEY GRAZING DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the JORDAN VALLEY GRAZING DISTRICT has been organized under the provisions of Chapter 273, Oregon Laws, 1933, with boundaries as follows to-wit:

Beginning one-fourth mile east of the northeast corner of Section 1, Township 24 south, Range 46 E. W. M., thence west on the township line to the center of the main channel of the Owyhee river; thence up the center of the main channel of said river to its junction with the south fork of the Owyhee River; thence up the center of the main channel of said south fork of the said Owyhee River to its junction with the Idaho-Oregon State Line; thence north along the Idaho-Oregon State line to the point of beginning.

AND NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT at a special election held within said district on the 8th day of September, 1933, the question of organizing said district was submitted to the voters therein, and said measure was duly carried and adopted and the result of said election canvassed by the canvassing board, as provided in Section 4 Chapter 273, Oregon Laws, 1933, under date of September 11th, 1933.

AND NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT by an Order of the Malheur County Grazing Board duly made and entered on the 16th day of September, 1933, it is ORDERED that from and after sixty (60) days from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, or corporation owning or having charge of any sheep, cattle, horses, or other livestock, to herd or graze the same or permit the same to be grazed or herded within such grazing district without having first procured a license from the County Grazing Board.

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to an order duly made by the County Court of Malheur County, Oregon, bearing date the 6th day of September, 1933, to me directed in the matter of the sale of lands bid in by said County for taxes and commanding me to sell the real property hereinafter described, that I shall on the 21st day of October, 1933, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, at the north main entrance door of the County Court House at Vale, Malheur County, Oregon, offer for sale at public auction, to the highest bidder therefor, the lands hereinafter described for not less than the prices fixed by the Court for each lot or tract, and the proportionate cost of publication to be added to each lot or tract so sold.
