Angler buying licenses to fish in 1934 in Oregon are being requested by the state game commission to submit a brief report on their catch of game fish to aid the department in preparing a survey.

Public notice is hereby given that pursuant to an order of the County Court dated March 7, 1934, to me directed in the matter of the sale of lands bid in by said County for taxes and commanding me to sell the real property belonging to said County and hereinafter described; I shall in compliance with the commands of said order and on the 14th day of April, 1934, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, at the north main entrance door of the County Court House at Vale, Malheur County, Oregon, offer for sale at public auction, to the highest and best bidder therefor the lands hereinafter described, for not less than the price fixed by said order for each tract or parcel, the cost of publication to be added to each lot or tract so sold.

Said lands will be offered for sale as follows: All tracts priced at \$200.00 or less to the highest and best bidder for cash; all tracts priced at more than \$200.00 and not more than \$500.00 to the highest and best bidder for cash or for not less than 20 per cent cash and the remainder to be paid under written agreement in equal installments over a period not exceeding five years, and all tracts priced at more than \$500.00 to the highest and best bidder for cash or for not less than 20 per cent cash and the remainder to be paid under written agreement in equal installments over a period not exceeding 10 years, all deferred payments to draw interest at 6 per cent payable annually and such agreements to be subject to all terms and conditions of Sections 69-813 and 69-836 Oregon Code, as amended by Session Laws of 1931 and 1933.

All lands within the boundaries of irrigation or drainage districts will be sold subject to any valid assessments made or to be made by said districts since the date said lands were acquired by the County, and all lands within the boundaries of the Warm Springs Irrigation District and which have been classified as in Classes 5 and 6, and as to which said County has heretofore by Resolution dated September 3, 1930, authorized a transfer to said district of the water rights appurtenant to said lands will be sold without water rights.
