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Geologists Says Oregon Has Oil; Hard to Get At

Although Oregon's peculiar geologic formations have made oil surveys difficult and probably will make extensive oil drilling difficult, this state has oil deposits which may be developed at some future time, according to Hugh A. Matier, geologist for the Union Oil company.

Matier told of scientific means now used in oil explorations. Even the seismograph used in earthquake recording is used to locate oil, he declared. By this method a charge of high explosive is detonated on the surface of the ground and the resulting "quake" reflected from rock formations underground is recorded and provides data for determining possibilities of oil-bearing ground.

A California company has purchased a large area of desert land in Malheur county, running from Jordan Valley southwesterly toward the Whitehorse ranch in Harney county, for oil investigations which will probably get under way this summer. The tract was purchased outright from the county.

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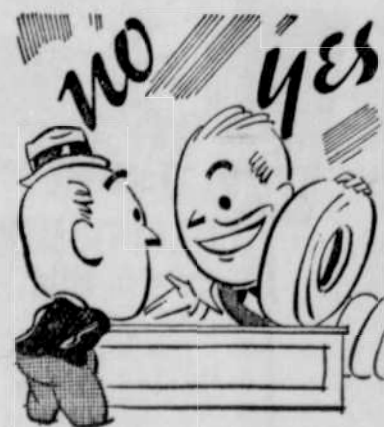
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
