APPLESAUCE COOKIES

Mrs. Virgil Johnson, Nyssa

One half cup butter, 1 egg, 1 teaspoon soda, 2 cups flour 1 cup raisins, 1 cup granulated sugar, 1 cup sweetened applesauce, ½ teaspoon each of cinnamon, cloves, nutmeg and salt, 1 cup chopped nut meats.

Cream butter then add sugar gradually. Add the beaten egg. Then add apple sauce after soda has been stirred in it. Sift the cloves, nutmeg, salt and cinnamon and flour together before adding them. Add the raisins and nuts.

Drop from a teaspoon onto a cookie pan and bake in a quick oven. Frost with 3 tablespoons of cream thickened with confectioner's sugar until it is of the consistency to spread. Flavor with vanilla. These cookies will keep moist a
