SHARING THE WEALTH

Another shortcut to Utopia, we've long since lost count of the number, they come so thick and fast in these days of readiness to try anything, is Huey Long's "share of wealth" movement. It is the subject of much ridicule, but suppose we consider it seriously as indeed it deserves to be for all know the country would be better off if wealth were much more evenly distributed than it is.

The proposal is to allow each wealthy mogul from four to 10 million dollars, Huey has changed the amount at different times, and to divide among the rest of us the remainder. Economists estimate that about 25 billion dollars are held by individuals worth 10 million apiece and up. Allowing them 10 million apiece or even four would subtract considerably from the amount to be divided, but suppose it were all divided, 25 billions among 125,000,000 persons would be only \$200 per person or \$1000 for a family of five, nothing to rave about for if it were spent which it couldn't be, it would only last a year or so. Income at five per cent, which is considerably more than the wealth of the nation averages to earn would net \$50 per family per year or \$10 per person per year. Clearly there is nothing in the Long plan for anyone to get excited about once it is understood.

But let's go farther and assume all the wealth of the nation were to be divided, which you may be sure, somebody will be advocating before long. Perhaps Huey will when the limitations of his present plan are pointed out to him. The wealth of the country is estimated at about 250 billions, which is \$200 per capita or \$10,000 per family of five. That is something. But on a return of five per cent this would only net a family of five \$500 a year which would leave all of us under the disagreeable necessity of continuing at work instead of all being able to quit and live off our incomes. This assuming business could continue to function a well under such a split-up of the means of production, which is more than doubtful.

For "wealth" can never be divided. It consists of lands, buildings, railroads, factories, etc. Suppose we divided up the U. P. railroad by each one taking a rail or two. We would only destroy its value completely and none of us would be any the richer. Suppose we did the same to the Ford Motor company plant, each one taking for himself a piece of intricate machinery. Same result. The wealth cannot be divided, only the income.

To divide the income we might seize in the name of the government the property and make it a government enterprise. That is all we could do, as anyone can readily see. But this would necessitate the government supplying the management, since Mr. Ford would probably take the four million or ten million left to him and depart for greener pastures. But would there be net profit if the government operated the industry of the nation? Not if the past history of the postoffice department and other government enterprises means anything. There would be much politics, many good jobs for congressman's relatives and friends but little if any net profit. Then where would be the benefit from the division? I wouldn't.

The "share of wealth" stuff is good politics under the present conditions, but it offers no hope of improving economic conditions. Better distribution of wealth and income are needed and in our opinion these can best be achieved by encouraging business instead of harrasing it, and levying on the really big incomes by sharply graduated income and inheritance taxes. This retains private management of industry, and individual initiative without which no civilization has ever progressed. But it tends to eliminate a highly developed society's greatest evil, the tendency for wealth to concentrate in few hands that cannot productively invest or spend it.

We shall probably never reach an ideal economic condition. It will not even be approached until Christian unselfishness replaces the present universal desire to grab everything in sight of one's self. Particularly we will accomplish nothing by fantastic schemes that tend to disorganize the productive processes of society.
