EXPLANATION IN ORDER

Word was received here Monday that Nyssa's application for a PWA loan and grant to construct a sewer system in Nyssa had been turned down by federal authorities. No information was given in the notice as to the reason for rejection of Nyssa's application, and was especially puzzling in view of the fact that Ontario was granted a gift of \$29,455 and a loan of \$36,000 to build a new grade school; and Vale was granted \$24,545 and a loan of \$30,000 to construct a union high school.

In comparing the valuation of the three cities as taken from the statement of taxes for 1934 prepared by Murray Morton, county assessor we find that the valuation of Vale was given as \$246,651.39, Nyssa \$318,155.78 and Ontario as \$839,551.36. The tax rate is lower in Nyssa, being 25.7 mills for city purposes in Nyssa as against 41.2 in Vale and 46.3 in Ontario.

The present sticker seems to be in the fact that Nyssa has approximately \$22,000 in bonds, including water works and street improvement bonds, and this exceeds the 5 per cent limitation as laid down by law. In a letter written September 23 it was indicated by federal authorities that any bonds Nyssa might vote for sewer purposes would have to be on a self-liquidating basis.

Whether a plan can be worked out to issue bonds on such a basis is doubtful but an effort is being made to secure this appropriation, which in all justice, is due Nyssa. In looking over the list of those receiving favorable consideration, we find Tulatatin. Now we have nothing against Tulatatin but facts remain that in 1930 the U. S. census showed Tulatatin had a population of 193 souls but in the PWA handout, they were granted \$12,273 and loaned \$15,000 to construct a waterworks and sewer system. This is more than Nyssa asked for. Another city that was successful in receiving favorable consideration was Malin, population 215. They received a grant of \$11,045 and a loan of \$13,500 to construct a sewer.

One of those who were at a loss to understand the government's action in the matter was Congressman Walter M. Pierce. In a telephone conversation Monday evening with his secretary, Mrs. Pierce, she said they had already addressed an inquiry to Washington to try and find out why Nyssa was not considered.

While the government's action has given the plans a set-back, city authorities have not given up hope and if at all possible, some plan will be worked out so that Nyssa can have their much needed sewer system.

Using Honey

With cooler days the family all enjoy hot breads for breakfast. Serve biscuits, muffins or hot cakes with honey which is quite warm. When preparing breakfast put the jar or dish of honey in hot water and set it in the back of the stove till serving time.

Prize Honey Muffins

4 tablespoons shortening; 4 tbs. honey, 2 tps. baking powder; 13-4 cups white flour; 1 egg beaten lightly 33-4 cup sour milk; 1 tps. soda; 1/2 tps. salt.

For darker muffins use Graham or whole wheat flour and 3-4 cups white flour. Beat thoroughly, bake in muffin tins in hot oven 20 minutes.

Have you tried using honey for part of the sweetening in your apple butter? You will find the flavor is improved. Add the honey after the butter is boiled down, as prolonged boiling spoils the color and flavor of honey.
