Think back yourself and enumerate the number of accidents you know within a radius of 100 miles from Nyssa and you can easily see why an active movement is underway to try and curb this ever increasing evil.

The causes of these many accidents are self evident. Faster cars are being built and it is only human to want to try them out; sometimes with fatal results. Another factor that can't be laughed off is that liquor is having some effect in the increased accident toll. One thing is certain, the present increasing highway deaths must be curbed. It is too big a matter to be disregarded. A sign of the automobile manufacturer's thought on the matter is seen in a campaign started by them to help curb accidents. They realize that unless there is a change for the better, it is going to seriously effect the sale of cars with consequent loss of business for manufacturers, dealers, gas companies, repair companies, finance companies, workmen, and the millions of people connected in one way or another with the automobile industry.
