HERE ARE THE SIMPLE RULES

No employee or near relative of any employee in the business office of this newspaper is eligible to enter this campaign.

Anyone else—regardless of age—living in this territory may enter this campaign. Correspondents will be allowed to compete.

In event of a tie for any one of the prizes, each tying candidate will be given a prize identical in value.

Only one nomination coupon, value 10,000 votes, will be credited to each candidate.

To insure absolute fairness the campaign will be brought to a close under a sealed ballot box. All subscriptions and money collected the last three days must be in the sealed ballot box when the campaign ends on Saturday, Sept. 5.

Votes will be issued on both new and old subscriptions. See schedule on this page. Credit for all extra votes will be issued at the convenience of the campaign manager.

Any candidate may have anyone — excepting another candidate — help her in any manner.

No candidate or candidates will be allowed to give or transfer subscriptions or votes to another candidate. With the consent of the campaign manager, however, any one candidate can transfer her votes to an entirely new candidate or new worker.

Candidates collecting more than one subscription before the starting day will be barred from the campaign.

Campaign starts August 15 and ends September 5.

After votes are issued on subscriptions each candidate will have full say as to how many are published in the printed standings of the candidates.

To be considered an active candidate and win a prize, each entry will be expected to turn in at least two subscriptions on every Wednesday and every Saturday, which shall be known as report days. Candidates are positively required to turn in all subscriptions they have on report day. (Every Wednesday and every Saturday.)

Prizes must be won in accordance with the conditions of the campaign and no candidate will be promised a certain prize for so many subscriptions or so much money.

Candidates may secure subscriptions any place or from any one. Candidates will not be confined to their own town or neighborhood in which to secure subscriptions but each will be given votes for all subscriptions she turns in.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

The Grand Capital Prize Diamond Ring will be given to the candidate, regardless of place of residence, who polls the largest number of votes in the campaign.

One of the District Capital Prize Diamond Rings will be given to the candidate living within the city limits of Nyssa having the highest number of votes after the Grand Capital Prize has been awarded.
