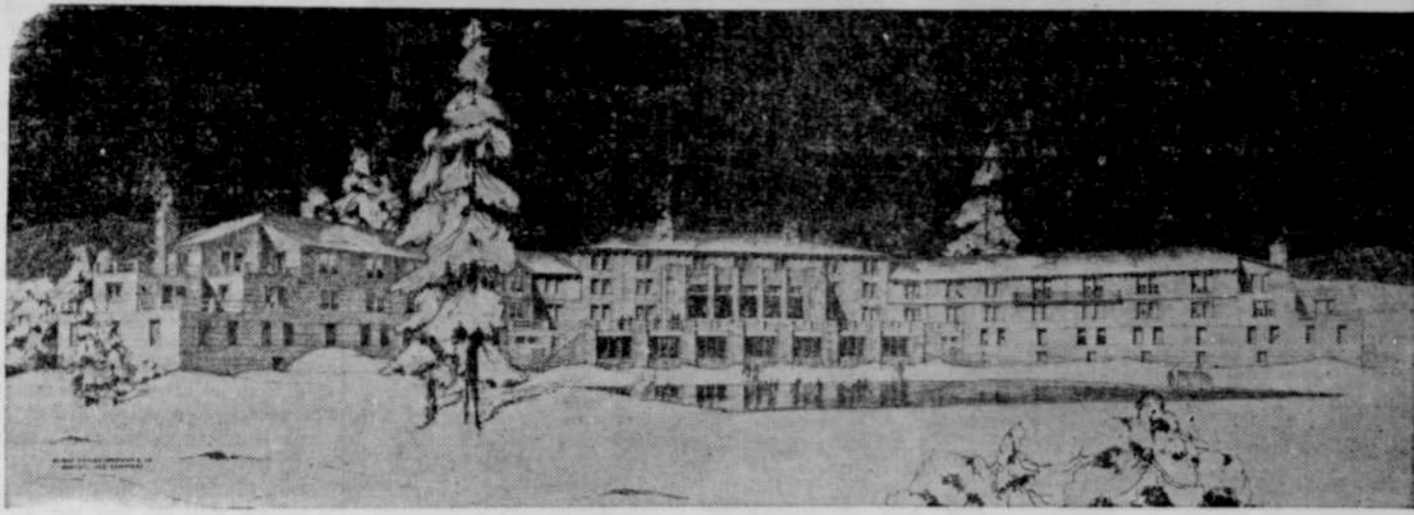
Mrs. Ralpheigh Van Buren took her daughter Genevieve to Ontario Tuesday where she will enter her first year of high school.

Sun Valley Lodge, New Idaho Winter Sports Mecca



The magnificent and palatial Sun Valley Lodge which the Union Pacific Railroad is building near Ketchum, Idaho, and which is to be opened for guests at the Christmas holidays, Sun Valley Lodge and its surrounding terrain is expected to be the winter sports mecca of America and to rival in magnificence similar sumptuous resorts in various European

The lodge will have accommodations for 200 guests. It is located on a 3300 acre ranch

a mile and a half north of Ketchum in Sun Valley where the surrounding mountains of the Sawtooth range protect it from the severe winter winds. Sun Valley is located in central southern Idaho northeast of Boise. It is sheltered by the lofty peaks of the Sawtooth mountain range, which runs east and west, and on the southern border of the rugged Salmon river country, one of

the last refuges of mountain sheep and goat. Count Felix Schaffgotsch, world famous gentleman-sportsman and skiing expert, selected the site of Sun Valley Lodge as the premier location for a winter sports center after an extensive inspection trip of all such possible areas in the mountain regions of western America.

KINGMAN KOLONY HOLDS RECEPTION FOR THEIR TEACHERS FRIDAY

Closing Hour For Air Mail Given

So that Nyssa citizens can enjoy full benefits of fast and frequent air mail schedules from the Pacific Northwest to California, the Midwest and East, Postmaster S. D. Goshert today issued a bulletin listing closing hours for such correspondence.

The postmaster pointed out that air mail often is delayed unnecessarily due to the fact that citizens fail to post their letters in time to make connections with southbound and eastbound planes. Air mail destined for California should reach the post office not later than 4:15 P. M. and that for the Midwest and East by 10:15 A. M. Air mail postage is six cents an ounce.

Postmaster Goshert emphasized that air mail is less expensive and frequently more effective than special delivery regular mail. He also called attention to the fact that air mail special delivery often can be used to advantage when such correspondence is scheduled to reach its destination after regular delivery hours.
