

# Wallace Berry To Appear At Boise Gigantic Pageant

Capital City Is Preparing For  
Gigantic Celebration, June 17, 18  
and 19th.

BOISE—Those throughout southern Idaho who are fans of Wallace Berry will be given a chance to see in the flesh the famed screen star, when he attends and participates in the "Idaho Marches On" celebration Thursday, Friday and Saturday of next week.

Berry announced through his personal friend, Herman Welker, Welker attorney, and Theo H. Wegener, celebration association president, he would fly from Hollywood Wednesday to arrive in time for the preview showing of the mammoth "Under the Stars" spectacle Wednesday night, June 16.

Though plans are not definite, he may be accompanied by Clark Gable, who has made arrangements to vacation in Idaho with Jerry Wray of Welker about the same dates as the celebration.

Berry will participate in each performance of the pageant. At the preview, he will crown "Miss Boise," the celebration queen, and will speak over the loud speaker system.

Meanwhile, Boise residents hastened activities in preparation for the celebration. Pipes have been laid and a boiler installed for the steam curtain—first ever used in Idaho. Electricians have wired the grounds and have placed sufficient lights to care for the 50,000-watt illumination system.

"If we had to pay every actor in our cast, rent, lease and buy all our properties and other paraphernalia to be used in this gigantic production, it would cost at least a quarter of a million dollars," Wegener said.

"Just think of it," he continued, "there are 2000 persons in the cast and costumes must be supplied for all of them. More than 500 horses will be used. Pulled, pushed and ridden across the 500-foot stage will be four covered wagons, several buggies and stagecoaches, many bicycles, scores of automobiles, two large model trains, guns and equipment of a full cavalry detachment. Motors of a dozen airplanes will roar overhead. Magnitude of the pageant can hardly be imagined."
