Puster and more than 25% of the resident freeholders of certain lands, the boundaries of which are herein-after more particularly set forth, proposing the organization of a Park and Recreation District, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 327, Oregon Law, 1941, duly filed with the County Clerk, and after a hearing on said petition and no person having appeared in opposition thereto or having objected to the boundaries of said district as proposed or having requested the inclusion of any lands therein, and upon the order of the County Court of Malheur County, Oregon, duly made and entered in its journal, the County Court has called and there will be held, within the boundaries of the proposed district, an election upon the question of whether or not such district shall be organized.

Such election will be held at the Grade School building in the City of Nyssa, in said proposed district on the 28th day of May, 1948 between the hours of 8:00 o'clock in the morning and 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day. At said election only resident freeholders within the proposed district, as shown by the last County assessment, shall be entitled to vote.

Dear A.F.: First of all, deafness is not uncommon; official surveys estimate that approximately 10 million people suffer from a loss of hearing! It's impossible to analyze a personal condition from a letter but the symptoms you outline are recognizable. Many people have hearing deficiencies in the lower registers.
