Hubert Parker left Wednesday for Eureka, California to spend the holidays with their son, Jack Parker.

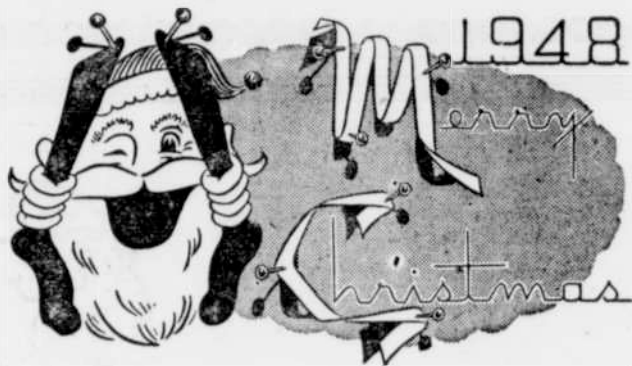

Notice hereby is given that, at the school district bond election hereby called, to be held at the Owyhee Elementary School in the County of Malheur, in and for School District No. 18 of Malheur County, Oregon, on the 4th day of February, A. D. 1949, between the hours of 2:00 o'clock P. M. and 7:00 o'clock P. M. there will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of contracting a bond in the sum of \$51,500.00 for the purpose of providing the funds needed for constructing an Elementary School in and for said District and for furnishing and equipping said Elementary School and for acquiring real property as an addition to the present Elementary School grounds within said District.

The vote to be by ballot upon which shall be the words "Bonds Yes" and "Bonds No", and the

voter shall place a cross (x) between the word "Bonds" and the word "Yes", or between the word "Bonds" and the word "No", which ever indicates his choice.
