SLOT MACHINES TO REMAIN UNDER BAN

Malheur Enterprise John Elfering, Malheur county sheriff-elect who will take office here early in January, served notice on slot-machine vendors that the machines would not be tolerated in the county under his administration. "The policy will remain the same as it has been under Sheriff Glenn," Elfering told the Enterprise. "Gambling of every type is against the laws of the state of Oregon and slot machines are one type that can and will be controlled in this county."

he said. "We will take gambling machines into custody wherever we find them." Elfering said that he planned to appoint his brother, Frank Elfering of Vale, as his deputy upon taking office and that he would name Joe Barnes of Vale as his tax deputy. Barnes, now employed by the Malheur Co-operative Electric association, has resigned from his present job effective January 1. Two other persons will complete the compliment of workers in the new sheriff's office and they will be chosen from those already employed there.
