"Shall the Charter of the City of Nyssa be amended by adding thereto a new Chapter authorizing the Council to construct and equip a fire house within the City of Nyssa, as an addition to the present fire house for the purpose of housing the fire equipment of the Nyssa Rural Fire Protection District, and to issue and sell general obligation bonds of the City of Nyssa in an amount not exceeding Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000.00) Dollars, to provide funds for said purpose, and authorizing a tax levy to pay the principal and interest of said bonds?"
