Contest Is Open To Green Guards

Malheur county's hundreds of Green members are being invited to take part in the 6th annual state-wide fire prevention poster contest sponsored each year by the Keep Oregon Green association. The hundreds of local Green Guards, the youth auxiliary of the Keep Oregon Green association, may enter contest posters from April 1 to 30, according to County Keep Oregon Green Chairmen, Klass V. Powell of Nyssa.

Green Guards will be divided into two divisions: Junior division including all members from 8 to 12 years of age, and the senior division, including those from 13 to 16 years old. Six cash prizes will be offered in each division with a \$25 cash award and a trip to the Oregon state forest nursery, near Oregon State college, Corvallis, to the two division first-place winners. The size of the poster will be 11x14. Only one poster may be submitted by each Green Guard. All posters will become the property of the Keep Oregon Green association, after judging.

Green Guard must use a fire prevention theme. The posters will be judged on originality, relation to educational phases of fire prevention and artistic qualities. They may be in cut-outs, water colors, poster paint, oils, pastels, or wax crayons.

Silver Medal Is Given Grider Cow

COLUMBUS, OHIO, (Special)—Sybil Gamble Pretty Polly, a registered Jersey cow owned by Hope and Charley Grider of Nyssa, has completed a production record of 8,530 pounds milk and 439 pounds butterfat, which has qualified her for the silver medal award of the American Jersey Cattle club, with headquarters in Columbus, O. Sybil Gamble Pretty Polly's record was made in 305-day actual production at the age of one year and 10 months. All her tests were verified by both Oregon State college and the American Jersey Cattle club.

In compiling this record she produced more than twice as much butterfat as the average dairy cow in the United States.
