

Equipment For Insect Treatment Is Suggested

Cattle can treat themselves for horn flies if given the proper equipment to work with, according to George Bain, county extension agent.

The equipment they need is some type of back scratcher treated with the proper insecticide. There are several good patented devices on the market for this

purpose. A hame made back scratcher can easily be made out of a chain or some barbed wire, some old sacks, some twine, and a few posts, the sacks, which are wrapped around the chain or wire and tied on securely with twine, are treated with a five percent solution of DDT, toxaphene, TDE, or methoxychlor in stove oil or light grade of fuel oil. To prepare this solution, add one quart of a 25 percent emulsifiable concentrate to four quarts of oil. Other concentrates of the insecticides can be used by figuring the percentage.
