Results of a series of rations made up of potatoes for fattening beef cattle will highlight the annual Livestock Feeders' Day at the Malheur experiment station, according to E. N. Hoffman, superintendent. The date of the event has been set for Wednesday, April 4, starting at noon.

Details of the program have not been completed but is expected

that the free lunch provided by various county civic groups will open the program.

Cattle have been on feed since last fall on rations made up of potatoes, straw, protein, stilbestrol and urea in various combinations. In addition, two groups have been fed different rates of ground corn and alfalfa hay. Complete results of the 125 day test will be available at the field day program, according to Hoffman.

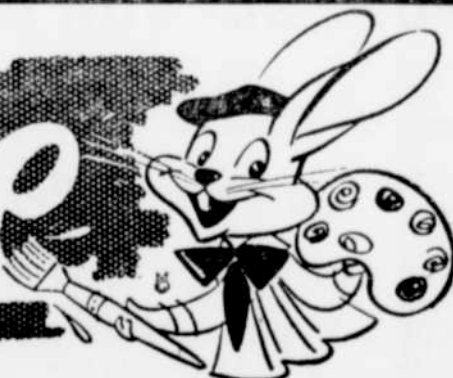
