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Speaker Deems Women's Part In All Phases Business, Government Good

"The women of our nation have for many years been active and prominent in affairs of government, but their importance is more appreciated during an election year than it is normally," Anthony Yturri told the study group of the Malheur county Republican's Women's council Monday afternoon at a meeting at the home of Mrs. Jessie Morgan. Yturri is a Republican candidate for state senator for Malheur, Grant and Harney counties.

The speaker pointed out that women have infiltrated into every conceivable walk of life and that they control a majority of the wealth of the nation. "The emergence of our women to an equality with men . . . has been fortunate," Yturri said. "Its result has been to double those forces in society that work toward the improvement of government, the preservation of democracy and the establishment of perpetual peace between nations and among men," he went on to say.
