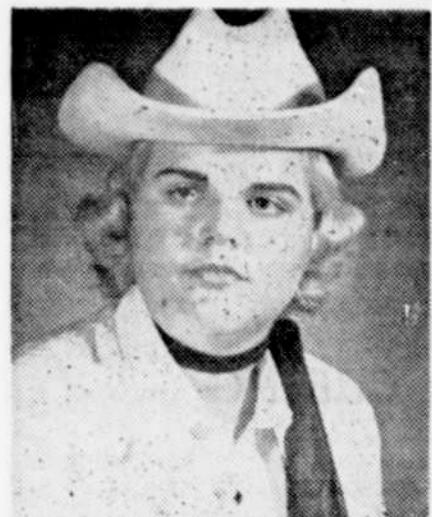


Nyssa's Big Annual Nite Rodeo All Set to Go Friday and Saturday With Events, Parades and Carnival

With many Rodeo Cowboy association champion riders coming to compete . . . with a big parade set for Nyssa's Main street both Friday and Saturday evenings at 7:45 preceding the rodeo events . . . and with a queen and two princesses (pictured below) all set to reign, Nyssa's eleventh annual Nite Rodeo promises to be the "biggest and best" yet ever staged here.

The annual rodeo will be held two nights this week, July 11 and 12, at the rodeo grounds on the southwest edge of the city with record crowds expected.

Approximately 200 head of rodeo stock will be furnished for the western event by Frank Prunty of Elko, Nev. Among major events planned to be featured are saddle bronc, bareback and Brahma bull riding, steer bulldogging, calf roping and kid's calf riding. The show will be Northwest Rodeo association and Idaho State Rodeo association approved, according to Lynn Snodgrass, general chairman.

Special Entertainment

Special entertainment will be a drill Friday night presented by the Caldwell Junior Riding club and one Saturday night presented by the Vale Sheriff's Posse. Snodgrass pointed out that formerly two drills have been presented each night, but plans were made this year for more horse and rodeo events.

Troy Neibors of Albany will be featured as clown of the gala two-day event, and will be bullfighting and staging specialty acts. Announcer will be Wayne Freeman of Caldwell.

A parade down Nyssa's Main street at 7:45 both Friday and Saturday evening preceding the rodeo will feature floats prepared by local organizations, riders and their mounts, possibly a band to lend spirit to the occasion and led by Rodeo Queen Susan Stringer and her Princesses Shirley Decker and Judy Gorrel.

Prizes Offered

The queen and her court were selected May 30.

Prizes will be awarded to the best entries in the two parades, Snodgrass said, and a \$1,000 purse is being offered contestants participating in the rodeo events.

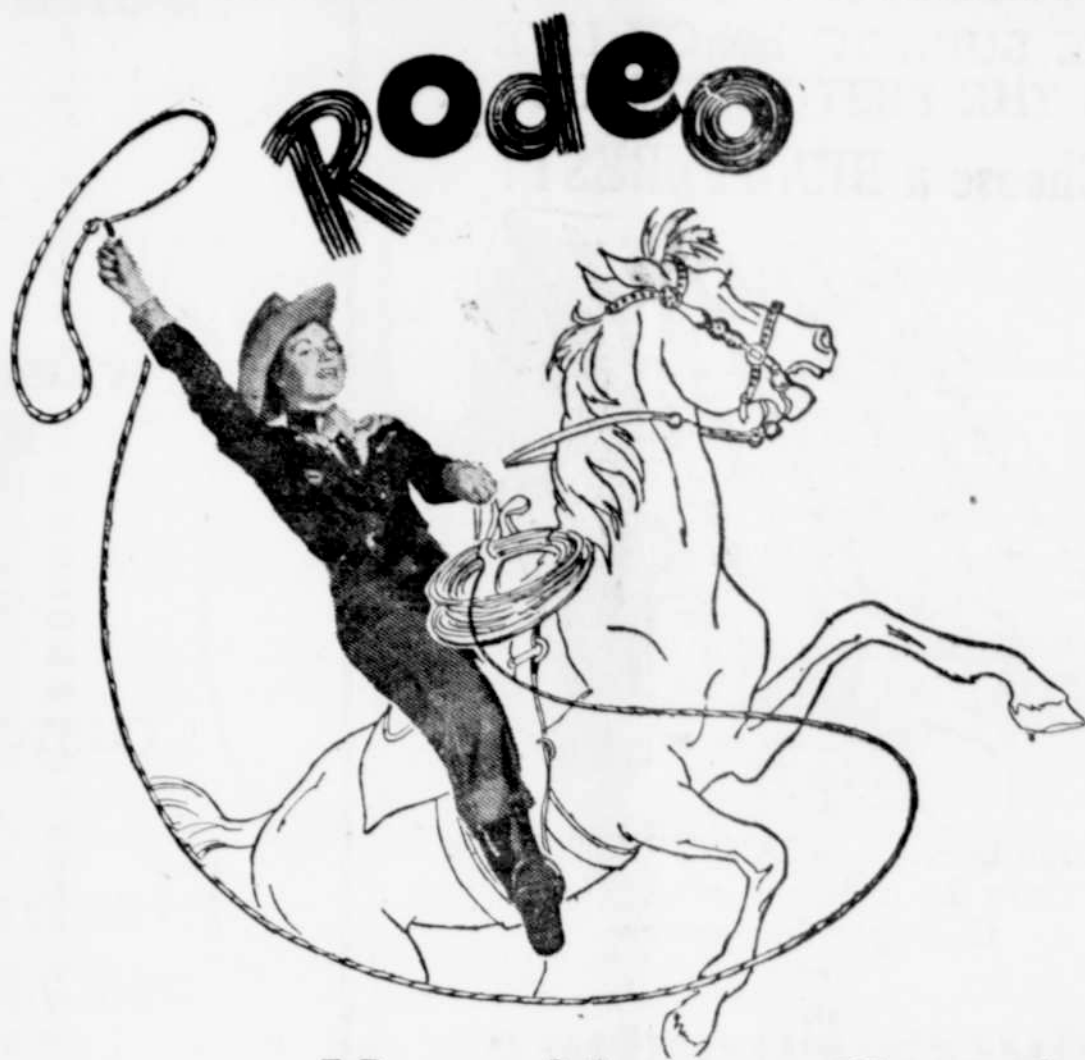
Jim Clayton, chairman of the

parade arrangements, has announced that prizes will be awarded for the best float entered, best decorated bicycle and for a drill team. Other prizes may be offered as details for parade categories develop, he indicated.

What's more, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, women's auxiliary drill teams, Legionnaires and churches of the community as well as clubs and organizations have all been urged to enter into the parade.

The rodeo grounds themselves have been readied and the corrals and chutes repaired for the two-day rodeo by several work parties of Owyhee Riding club members. A new water line has also been installed to the rodeo grounds this year to take care of all facilities and the area to be occupied by the annual carnival.

Sparkling the rodeo celebration will be the carnival, brought here by the Davis Amusement Co. This carnival, which has visited Nyssa for the annual event before and won commendation for top-notch entertainment, turned down an engagement at Cottage Grove to appear here again this year, according to the general chairman.
