

### Rudolph Hite, Rancher Dies Wed.

Mr. Rudolph Hite of route 1, Nyssa, passed away Wednesday noon in the Malheur Memorial hospital following a heart attack. He had suffered previous attacks but was still very active and had spent this past Sunday fishing up on the lake.

Mr. Hite was born Jan. 16, 1876, in Kansas, moved to the Teuton valley with his pioneer family from Holland, and later moved to Cascade, Idaho, where he married Lillie Blanche Cantrall. The last 42 years he has lived on the Owyhee river where has been a very active farmer and rancher.

He was preceded in death by his wife and three children. Surviving are three sons, Oral and Omar of Nyssa, and Jim of Haines, Ore.; four daughters, Verna Kenney, The Dalles, Ore., Wanda Foss of Vancouver, Wash., Lila Johnston of Ashland, Ore., and Betty Wilson of Nyssa; 21 grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at the Owyhee Community church Saturday at 2 p.m. under the direction of Lienkaemper Funeral Home with the Rev. Robert O. Jackson officiating.

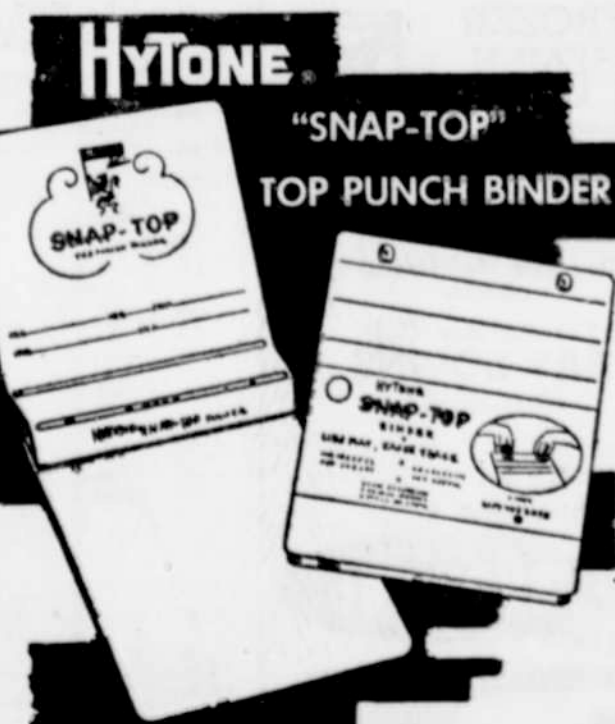
