That the City of Nyssa charter be amended by adding a new chapter authorizing extension of the sewage distribution system, improvement of sewage treatment facilities, improvement of main trunk lines, pump stations and other sewer facilities, acquisition of sites, easements and rights of way therefor, issuance and sale of general obligation bonds of the City not exceeding \$175,000 to provide funds therefor, authorizing pledging of all or part of net earnings of said system and authorizing a tax levy in sufficient amount to pay principal and interest of said bonds when ever necessary to supplement available sewer revenues?
