State Farm Youth Invited to Apply For Trips Abroad

Young men and women with a sincere desire to contribute to better world understanding by living with overseas families are invited to apply for trips abroad as International Farm Youth Exchange (IFYE) delegates. Applications are being taken at county extension offices or the state 4-H club office at Oregon State university.

Qualifications for applicants are these: must be single, between 20 and 30 years of age, have some farm background and be willing to adapt to home situations in other lands. Foreign language would be helpful but is not a requirement, says Ruth Brasher, state 4-H extension agent at OSU.

Applications for trips must be turned into OSU by Aug. 5. Candidates will be selected by personal interview Aug. 12 in Corvallis. Four youths will be nominated for trips. Their names will be sent to the National 4-H Club Foundation in Washington, D.C., for final selection and assignment.

IFYE delegates spend four to five months in a host country living with assigned families two to three weeks. An IFYE shares with the family as a family member—in work and leisure activities.

A two-way exchange, the program is financed by private donations, part from the state and
