Shoppers Given Roadside Stand Purchasing Tips

If roadside stands tempt your taste for home-grown fruits and vegetables, first compare quality and costs of these outdoor offerings with those at local markets.

Zelma Reigle, Oregon State university extension food marketing specialist, suggests that shoppers note differences among roadside stands in quality, price and convenience to assure most satisfying buys. Here are some things to look for in shopping at outdoor stands:

Produce on roadside markets should be kept cool and shaded at all times. Most fresh fruits and vegetables lose quality if exposed to sun and heat for any length of time.

Look for signs of careful management—trimmed produce, orderly grounds and clean containers. Does it appear that produce is harvested to assure rapid turnover from field to shopper?

When comparing roadside and store prices, consider costs of trimmed and untrimmed produce. All prices should be clearly marked.

Ideally, roadside charges should range somewhere between wholesale and retail charges. Prices at roadside stands may change less frequently than those at retail markets. This can be an advantage or a drawback.

Some roadside markets, not directly connected to a growing area, purchase produce through wholesale outlets the same as retail stores. Price tags found at these types of stands often compare closely with those of local food stores, she says. But, in some cases, they may be higher because shoppers, swayed by the outdoor atmosphere, feel they are receiving fresher produce and are willing to pay a little extra.
