Federal Land Bank Declares Dividend

The Federal Land Bank association of Ontario has declared a \$9,631.40 dividend to its stockholders. Dan E. Roberts, association manager, who announced the dividend, said 444 farmers and ranchers in this area will share in the money and that the checks are being prepared for mailing before Christmas.

Roberts said the association dividend resulted from a \$535,000 dividend declared by the Federal Land Bank of Spokane to stockholders of record Nov. 30, 1961. The bank's capital is entirely owned by 62 federal land bank associations in the four northwest states. Association stock is owned by its member-borrowers.

Since 1944, the Spokane bank has paid \$4,900,000 in dividends and the Ontario FLBA has distributed \$58,082.56 to its stockholders, according to Roberts. The FLBA of Ontario serves Malheur, Payette, Adams and Washington counties.
